ACCOMMODATIONS LIST

Motels/Hotels/Bed and Breakfasts: all will charge at least \$10 fee for pets and all prices are subject to change. Make sure to mention you are with the Elks Convention.

*Salmon River Front – 1-800-756-4281 – 503 Hwy 93 North: They have smoking & nonsmoking, double, queen, and king beds, plus kitchenettes with two bedrooms. They are approximately four blocks from the lodge and rooms go for \$62 for double/queen and \$51 for single/king plus tax.

*Stagecoach Inn – 208-756-2919 (**Headquarters Hotel – Block of rooms available, must reserve and guarantee by October 1, 2018**) – 201 Hwy 93 North: They have 98 rooms, smoking & nonsmoking,

continental breakfast, swimming pool, and are approximately six blocks from the lodge. Room are \$90 and up plus tax depending on #of people in room, kind of room. Wireless internet, Refrigerator and microwave in some of the rooms on the river side of the hotel.

*Sac Inn – 208-756-2294 – Hwy 93 South: 21 nonsmoking rooms with mini fridges in all rooms and are 1 ½ miles from the lodge. Rates are \$50 and up plus tax, depending on # of people and # of beds.

*Bear County Inn – 208-1499 – 1015 Main Street: 41 rooms, King and Queen beds, No Smoking Rooms, Pets Welcome, Wireless Internet, located approximately one mile from the lodge. Rates are \$50 and up depending #people and #beds, 4 smoking rooms.

*Super 8 – 208-756-8880 - 104 Courthouse Drive: 30 rooms, non-smoking, flat screen TV, DVDs. Rates are \$80 and up. They are approximately ¾ mile from the lodge and very close to downtown. Let them know you are with the convention and discounts may apply.

BED AND BREAKFAST:

*Syringa Lodge – 208-756-4424 – 2000 Syringa Drive: They have 8 beds, 6 baths and has an excellent view of the Salmon valley. They are 1 mile from the lodge and downtown. Rates are double \$100.00, includes full breakfast.

*Solaas Bed & Breakfast – 208-756-3903 – 9 miles east on Hwy 28(CASH ONLY): They have 7 rooms with a no indoor smoking policy and are 10 miles from the lodge. Rates are double w/private bath \$50.00 and single w/private bath \$40.00.

*Greyhouse Inn – 800-348-8097 – 12 miles south on Hwy 93: All nonsmoking rooms and go for \$65.00 w/shared bath or \$75.00 w/private bath. Approximately 6 rooms.

100 Acre Wood – 208-865-2165 – 33 miles north on Hwy 93: Five rooms range from \$55.00 to \$95.00. Also have excellent full-service dining restaurant.

RV CAMPGROUNDS:

Elks Lodge – 208-756-3332 – 12 spaces with full hookups. Rate is \$25.00/night.

Century Campground – 208-756-2063 – Five blocks from the lodge on Hwy 93. Traffic noise.

Salmon Meadows Campground – 208-756-2640 – ¾ mile from lodge on 400 N St. Charles St.

North Fork Campground – 208-865-2412 – North Fork, Idaho 20 miles north of Salmon on Highway 93.

MEETING ROOMS OTHER THAN LODGE:

Stagecoach Inn – 208-756-4251 – NO ALCOHOL Large room has a capacity of 130. Rate of \$80.25 for 9 hrs. Small room has a capacity of 35. Rate of \$10.00 for first hour and \$5.00/hr thereafter.

City Center – 208-756-3214 – Has a capacity of 150. Rate of \$25.00 for ½ day and \$50.00 for a full day. An extra charge of \$25.00 if food is served.
